The activities must be met within one Girl Scout year. Parents with daughters in multiple troops must complete four activities with each troop.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. Attend a troop activity or event.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 6. Attend a service area or council event with your daughter's troop.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. Participate in and help with a troop camping trip.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. Make arrangements with your daughter's troop leader to attend and help at a troop meeting.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. Serve as a program consultant for a troop meeting.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 10. Do something special on Leader's Day (April 22) to show appreciation for the troop leader and assistant leader's efforts.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 11. Contribute to the council's Annual Giving campaign.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 12. Contribute to the council's Commit to a Girl campaign.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 13. Encourage other parents to register as troop committee members.
